In February 2022, the MCPD approved a Commissioner to serve as alternate on the Joint Inclusion Committee. Secondly in March, the MCPD approved the 2022-2023 budget recommendation plan for better quality of life recommendations for the disabled population of Austin. This includes a request for funding for a single-stall gender- neutral wheelchair accessible bathroom & adult-sized changing table at Zilker Park. Thirdly in March, a draft recommendation was approved to move the Americans with Disabilities Act program into the Civil Rights Office. In June, the MCPD held a joint meeting with the Commission on Seniors. During that meeting, we had an update on the results of the Quality of Life Study from the Public Consulting group. Additionally in June, representatives from Capital Metro spoke on updates regarding strollers on public transit and Project Connect. In regards to the missing months for this review, we did have the inability to reach quorum for the majority of the year.
