Posting Language

Authorize execution of a contract for shoebox style luminaires and poles with Techline, Inc., for a term of five years in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.

For the goods required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established].

Funding in the amount of \$87,500 is available in the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the remaining contract term is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

The Financial Services Department issued an Invitation for Bids (IFB) 1100 DNJ1027 for these goods. The solicitation was issued on July 4, 2022, and closed on August 2, 2022. Of the two offers received, the recommended contractor submitted the lowest responsive offer.
