RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing in accordance with Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Chapter 26 to consider a resolution authorizing a change in use of dedicated parkland, known as Pioneer Crossing Neighborhood Park, to enable the Austin Transportation Department (ATD) to construct and use approximately 9,574 square feet of permanent drainage easements as part of the East Braker Lane extension project. (the "Proposed Use"); and

WHEREAS, ATD requires approximately 9,574 square feet of permanent drainage easements; and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibit A (the "Affected Land"); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on March 9, 2023, was given for three consecutive weeks on February 12, 19, and 26 in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held on March 9, 2023, by the City Council to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
