- 4. Recommend approval to negotiate and execute a contract for water loss program review, analysis, and optimization with **Black & Veatch Corporation**, for a term of one year in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.

- 5. Recommend approval to negotiate and execute a contract for parts and repair services for the process air blower, with **Howden USA Company** for a total amount not to exceed \$150,000.
- 6. Recommend approval to negotiate and execute a contract for parts and services to recondition a 72-inch screw pump with EWT Holdings III Corp. d/b/a Evoqua Water Technologies, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.
- 7. Recommend approval to execute a contract for sodium chloride with **TR International Trading Company**, for a term of five years in an amount not to exceed \$1,680,000.
- 8. Recommend approval to execute a contract for liquid sulfur dioxide with **DXI Industries Inc.** for a term of five years in an amount not to exceed \$4,240,000.
- 9. Recommend approval to award and execute a construction contract with **MA Smith Contracting Co., Inc.,** for the Burnet Road Corridor AE Kramer Site Drainage project in the amount of \$12,088,426.75 plus a \$1,813,264.01 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$13,901,690.76.
- 10. Recommend approval to amend two contracts for continued Advanced Meter Infrastructure systems, including meters, meter installation, a data platform, and customer portal, with Meter Reading Holding, LLC dba Aclara Technologies, LLC or Aclara Smart Grid Solutions, LLC and Vertex U.S. Holdings, Inc. dba VertexOne Software LLC or Watersmart Software Inc, for an increase in the amount of \$7,934,000 for a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$103,000,000, divided between the contractors.
