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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 2. On February 9, 2023, Texas Gas Service Company (TGS) filed a proposed interim rate adjustment or Gas Reliability Infrastructure Program (GRIP) filing in Austin and in the other cities it serves in the Central Gulf Service area (CGSA). The other cities include Bayou Vista, Beaumont, Bee Cave, Cedar Park, Cuero, Dripping Springs, Galveston, Gonzales, Groves, Jamaica Beach, Kyle, Lakeway, Lockhart, Luling, Nederland, Nixon, Port Arthur, Port Neches, Rollingwood, Shiner, Sunset Valley, West Lake Hills and Yoakum, Texas. TGS is seeking recovery of \$104,175,258 in invested capital for the period of January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

PART 4. Pursuant to Texas Utilities Code § 104.301, the City is authorized to suspend the implementation of the interim rate adjustment for a period not to exceed 45 days beyond the effective date proposed by TGS.

PART 6. The implementation of the interim rate adjustment in TGS's GRIP filing proposed to take effect on April 10, 2023, is hereby suspended until the sooner of (a) the 45th day from the proposed effective date, or (b) the date acted upon by the City Council.
