## Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a cooperative contract to provide consulting services for strategic plan development with ISF, Inc., for a term of one year in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.

The contract will provide strategic planning and data modernization services. These services will help Austin Public Health develop a business and data strategy plan, implement the plan, monitor capacity, close gaps, and develop a workforce development strategic plan related to data modernization. All of these are crucial to carry out Austin Public Health's long-term strategic goals.
