The Texas Health and Human Services Commission offers a Community Partner Program, through which eligible entities can provide residents online community-based application assistance for SNAP, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, Medicaid, Long-term Care Services, and the Children's Health Insurance Program. The City's neighborhood centers currently provide basic needs services to residents, including emergency food, case management, and preventive health services. Participation in the Community Partner Program will help reduce barriers to SNAP enrollment and other Health and Human Services Commission benefit programs.
