Located along Waller Creek between Lady Bird Lake and 4th Street


Identified in Councilapproved Waller Creek Design Plan

Approximate 14-acre project area. Creek restoration, 1 mile of new trails, pedestrian bridges, water quality and utility improvements


Construction starts Spring 2023












Lagoon Overlook + Leaf Deck






Lakeview Terrace & Explorer's Garden
