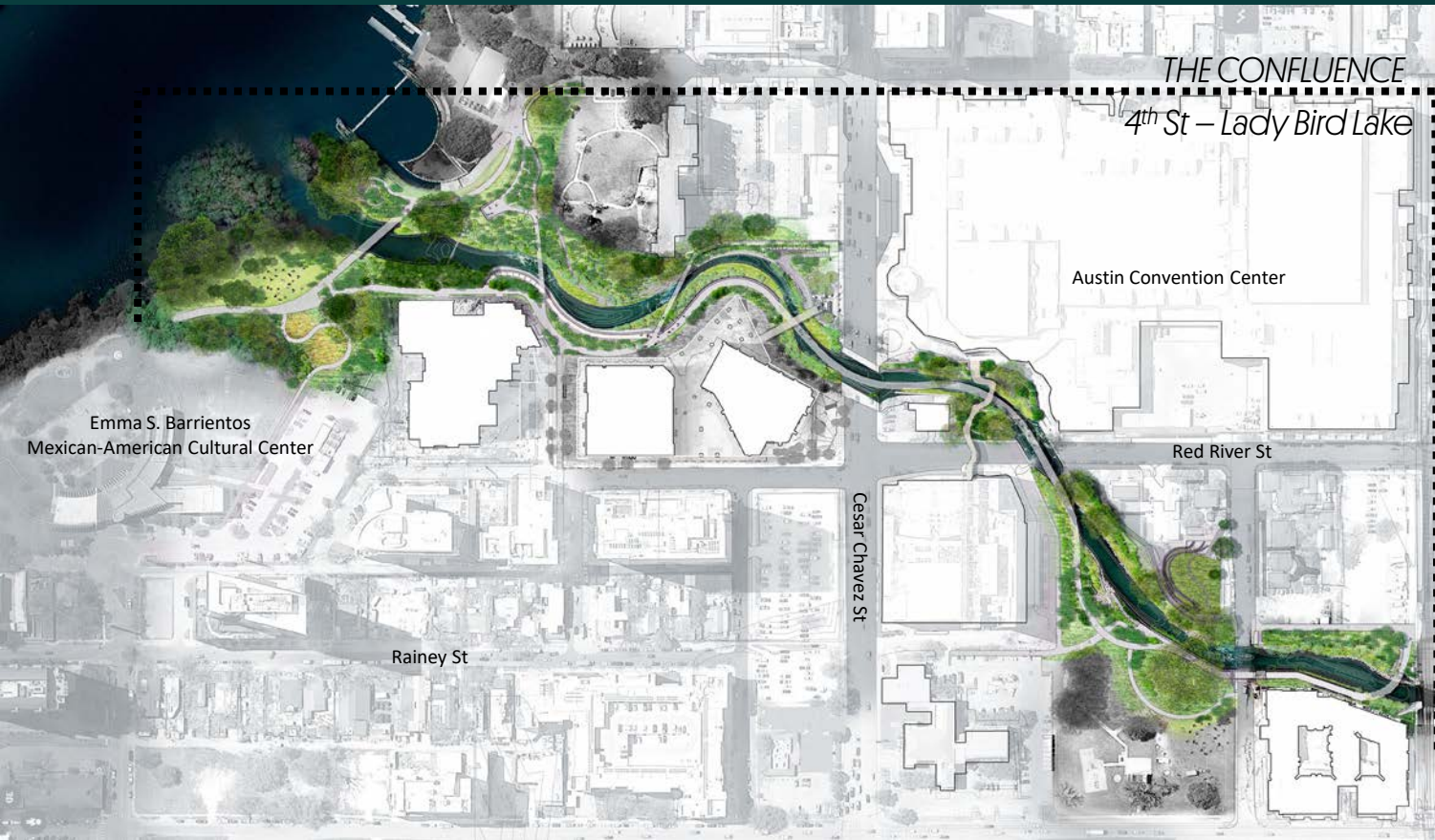


Mission

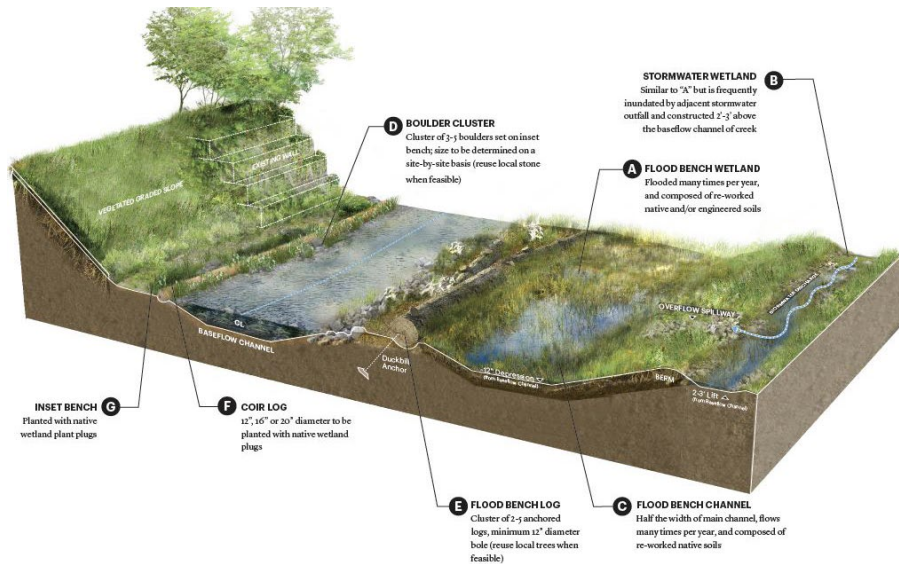

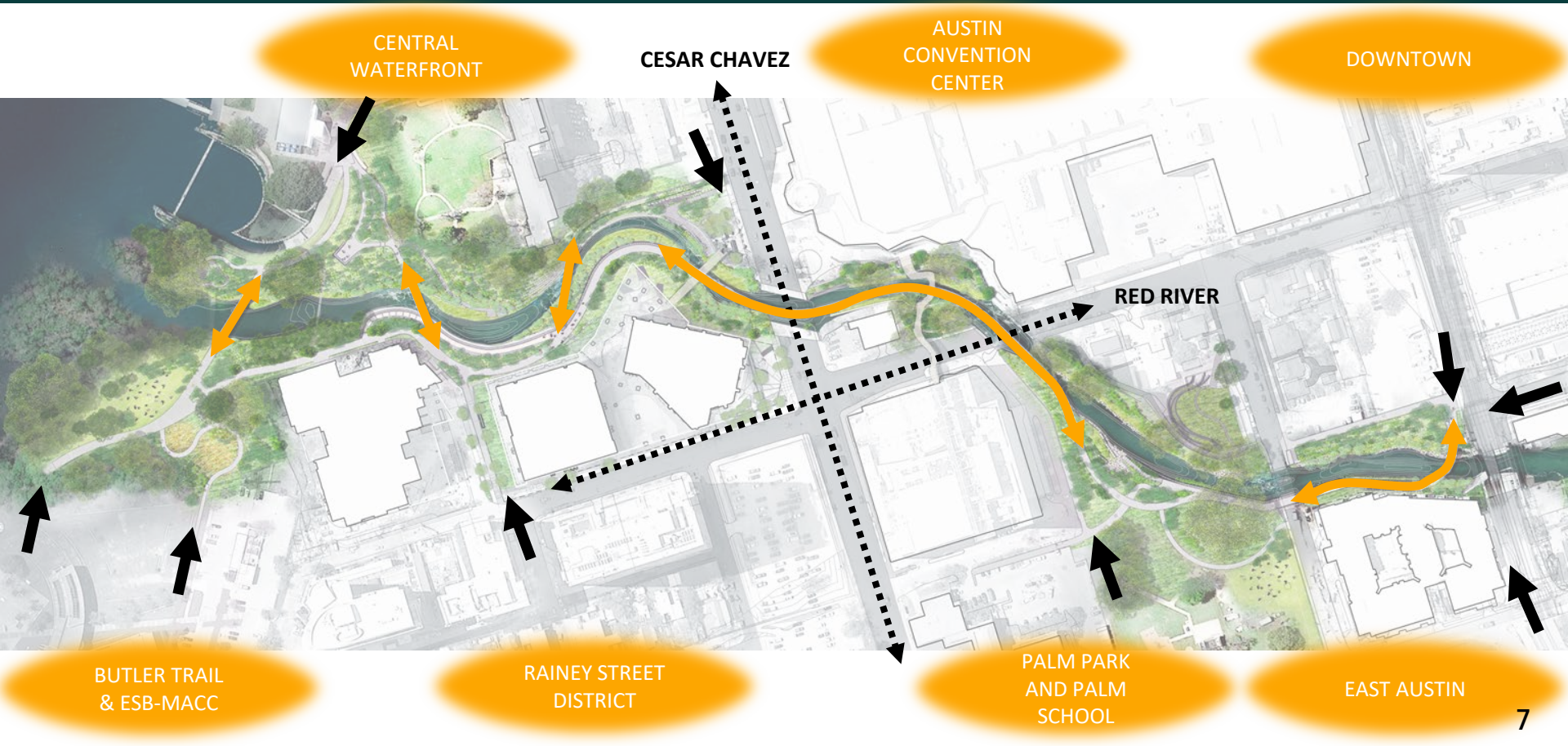

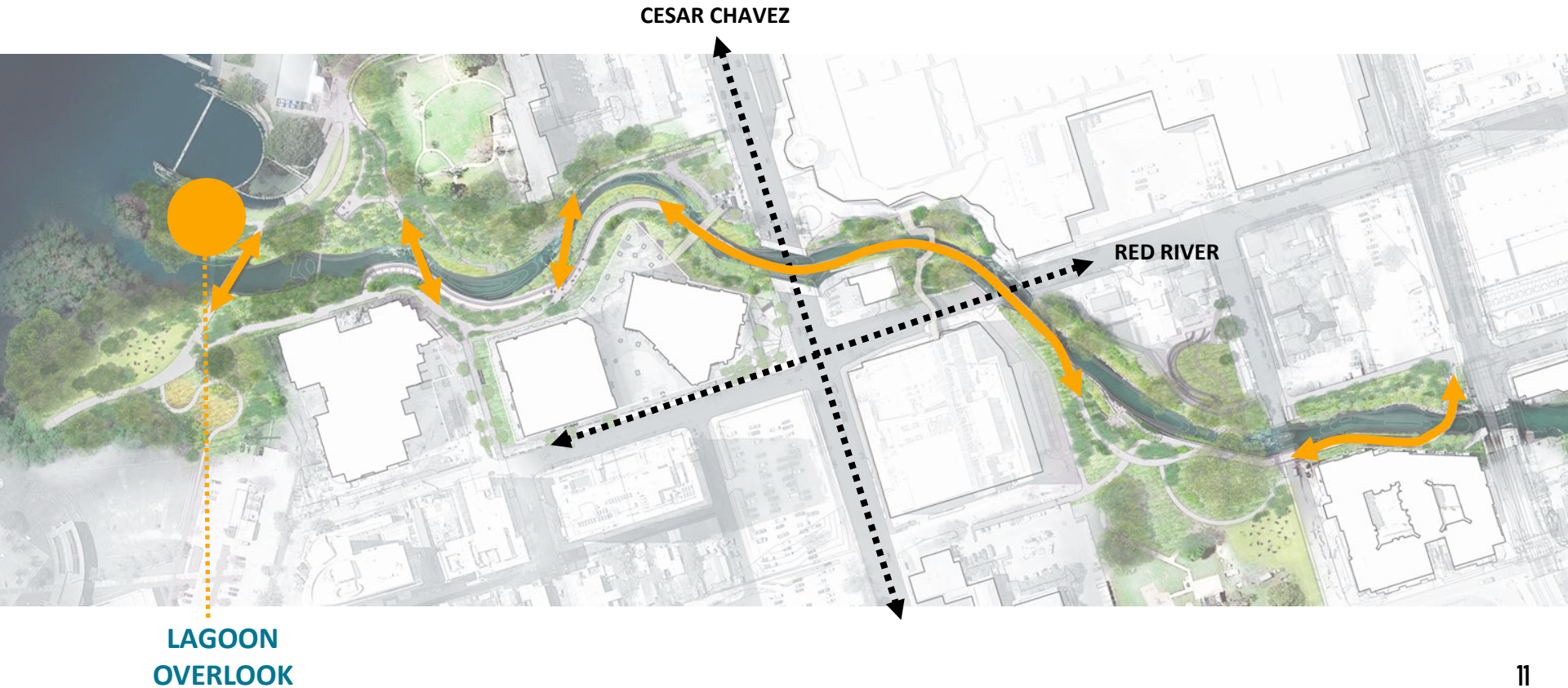

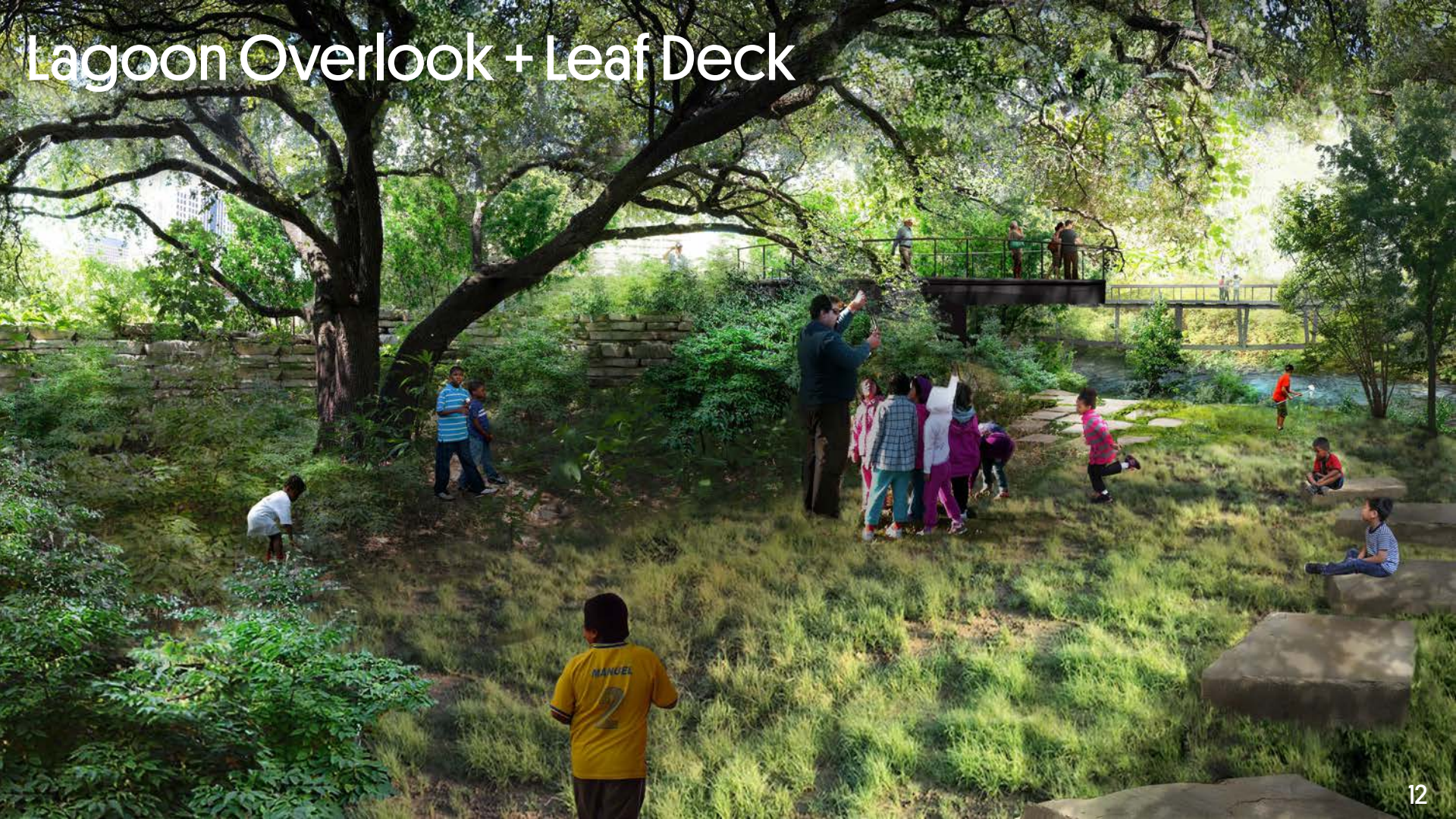

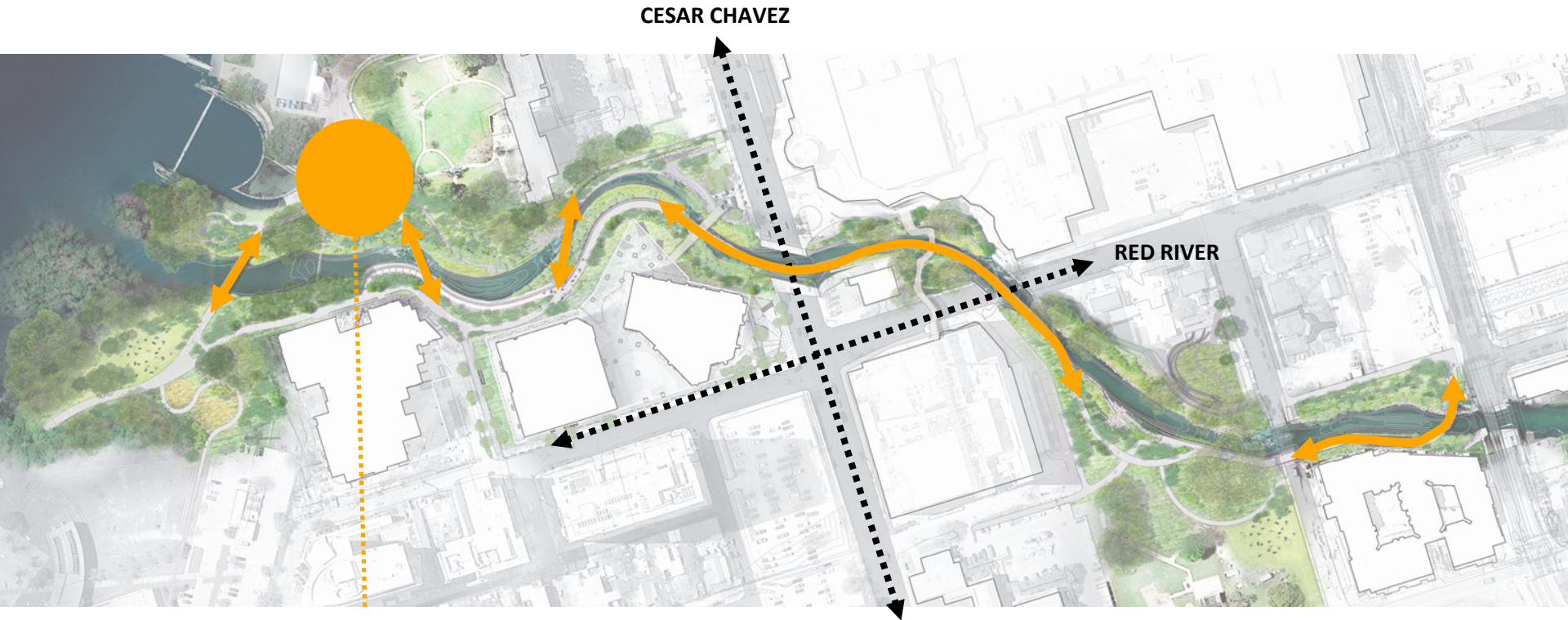
