Subject: Watershed Protection Department FY 2022-2023 Budget, Programs, and Projects

RATIONALE:

WHEREAS, the Environmental Commission is charged with the review and recommendation of the Watershed Protection Department's (WPD) annual Financial Forecast and five-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Plan;

WHEREAS, the FY24 Capital Improvement Program outlines WPD's projected major improvements during the next year based on existing funds and anticipated revenues; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Commission understands the five year CIP plan is still being prepared and will be provided to the Commission in near future; and

THEREFORE, the Environmental Commission supports the Watershed Protection Department's Budget, Programs, and Projects as presented in the backup presented to the Commission.

With the following Environmental Commission recommendations:

- 1. WPD continue to look for Federal grant funding for capital improvements;
- 2. Monitoring of homeless encampment for surface and groundwater impacts;
- 3. WPD should critically review if increases to the Drainage Utility Fees increases or if a near future stormwater bond is necessary are needed to maintain the level of service for the public.
- 4. WPD will critically review any reductions in development fees.
