Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract for tactical carrier vests with Atlantic Diving Supply, Inc. d/b/a ADS, Inc., for 34 months for a total contract amount not to exceed \$644,000.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide multi-piece tactical carrier vests with accessories for the Austin Police Department's (APD) Special Weapons and Tactics Team and Organized Crime Division to replace expiring vests as needed for APD officers. The tactical carrier vests have a multi-platform modular design which allows officers to change and adapt the vest with minimal effort and maximum efficiency, while still providing ballistic bicep, neck, groin, and torso coverage. Officers will be able to configure the vest depending on the environment, threat, and operational requirement. The vest has antimicrobial spacer mesh and padding, making it breathable and more comfortable during the summer months, and it can be scaled down to a plate carrier if required.

The current contract for these goods expired April 10, 2023. The requested authorization amount was determined using the current inventory of vests and their expiration dates as well as estimates of future requirements.

The Sourcewell cooperative establishes competitively bid contracts that can be utilized by the State and other government agencies through a cooperative agreement. Cooperative agreements save taxpayer dollars by leveraging the State's volume-buying power to drive down costs on hundreds of contracts through a streamlined cooperative purchasing program.

If a contract is not secured, the City will not have a reliable source for tactical carrier vests and will be forced to procure these goods on an as-needed basis, which may result in higher prices.
