Additional Backup Information:

The City Manager's Office reviewed this grant for alignment as directed by Resolution No. 20200611-096 and recommends approval.

This action will provide the required resolution needed by the State's Criminal Justice Division to complete the award process related to \$275,424 in grant funding. The project period is October 1, 2022 - September 30, 2023. A match is not required. Funding will allow the City to purchase 41 National Institute of Justice-rated ballistic shields to more safely and efficiently respond to active attack emergencies.

The grantor requires a resolution approved by Council that includes items one through four below.

- 1. Authorization by your governing body for the submission of the application to the Public Safety Office (PSO) that clearly identifies the name of the project for which funding is requested;
- 2. A commitment to provide all applicable matching funds;
- 3. A designation of the name and/or title of an authorized official who is given the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant (Note: If a name is provided, you must update the PSO should the official change during the grant period.); and
- 4. A written assurance that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to PSO.
