
#### **AUSTIN IS MOBILE AND INTERCONNECTED**






## What Light Rail needs to be:

- Transit workhorse that feeds, collects, distributes to the rest of the transit network
- Enables mode shift
- Includes critical access to and from the line (first/last mile, ped, bike)
- Creates a core for system for future expansion
- Light Rail is One large piece of Project Connect






















## **CURRENT EMPLOYMENT DENSITY**
