Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Service Agreement with the Austin Housing Finance Corporation by increasing funding to the Austin Transit Partnership Grant Fund by \$34,000,000, the 2022 General Obligation Bond Fund by \$45,000,000, and the Housing Trust Fund by \$920,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$114,807,251.
