<u>Transportation Public Works projects:</u>

- 1. Preliminary Engineering Report for Red Line Trail between Brushy Creek Trail to the south side of SH 45. Ties into the Brushy Creek Regional Trail identified in the Williamson Comprehensive Parks Master Plan by providing an off-street connection from the existing Brushy Creek Trail to SH 45. Follows Tier 1 section of Red Line trail as show in 2023 Urban Trails Plan.
- McNeil Road shared use path. Improvements to Williamson County section of McNeil Road, currently a substandard arterial street that lacks sidewalks on both sides of the street and has open ditch drainage. The project would add a shared use path on the north side of the street between San Felipe Boulevard and Corpus Christi Drive for both the sidewalk/ADA path and westbound bicycle facility.
- 3. Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS) improvements for Elsa England Elementary and Pearson Ranch Middle Schools (Round Rock ISD). The Elsa England ES/Pearson Ranch MS SRTS scope of work includes converting the existing painted bike lanes into protected bike lanes along Neenah Avenue from Iveans Way to the school driveway and along Pearson Ranch Road from Avery Ranch Boulevard to Neenah Avenue, as well as installing a flex post protected intersection at Neenah Avenue and Pearson Ranch Road.
