The agreement allows for Multnomah County, Oregon to utilize a contract for veterinary pharmaceuticals and supplies with Midwest Veterinary, Inc., WA Butler Company/Covetrus North America, LLC, and Boehringer Ingelheim Animal Health USA, Inc.

A cooperative purchase agreement is an agreement between governmental entities establishing the legal grounds for participating governmental entities to establish and share cooperative contracts. The City enters into cooperative purchase agreements to access the cooperative contracts of other governmental entities, as well as to share the City's cooperative contracts with other governmental entities. By cooperatively purchasing goods and services, this increases the spend on the City contract, enabling the City to better leverage pricing in future contracts.

The agreement is entered into under the provision of Chapter 271, Subchapter F, Texas Local Government Code.
