Prior Council Action:

June 9, 2022- City Council approved Resolution No. 20220609-066 that initiated an amendment to City Code Title 25 that would modify the application of compatibility to projects on certain corridors, such that compatibility would generally be reduced.

December 1, 2022- City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20221201-056 to amend City Code Chapter 25-2 to create the Corridor Overlay District which applies to properties that front-face or side-face certain roadways.

Additional Backup Information:

Ordinance No. 20221201-056 omitted several corridor segments included in the original direction provided by City Council. The recommendation would amend Ordinance No. 20221291-056 to correct corridor extents in order to make the ordinance consistent with Council's original intent.
