

RESOLUTION NO. 20230420-043

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioners Court is in the process of considering a road and park bond election for November 2023; and

WHEREAS, as part of the evaluation process, the Williamson County Citizen's Bond Committee is accepting proposals from cities within Williamson County for projects to be included in the November 2023 bond election; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for the submittal of proposed projects is April 28, 2023; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit the following projects to the Williamson County Citizen's Bond Committee as candidates for inclusion in the November 2023 Williamson County Road and park bond election:

- **Preliminary Engineering Report for Red Line Trail between Brushy Creek Trail to the south side of SH 45.** Ties into the Brushy Creek Regional Trail identified in the Williamson Comprehensive Parks Master Plan by providing an off-street connection from the existing Brushy Creek Trail to SH 45. Follows Tier 1 section of Red Line trail as shown in 2023 Urban Trails Plan.
- **McNeil Road shared use path.** Improvements to Williamson County section of McNeil Road, currently a substandard arterial street that lacks sidewalks on both sides of the street and has open ditch drainage. The project would add a shared use path on the north side of the street between

San Felipe Boulevard and Corpus Christi Drive for both the sidewalk and a westbound bicycle facility.


- **Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS) improvements for Elsa England Elementary and Pearson Ranch Middle Schools (Round Rock ISD).** The Elsa England Elementary School and Pearson Ranch Middle School SRTS scope of work includes converting the existing painted bike lanes into protected bike lanes along Neenah Avenue from Iveans Way to the school driveway and along Pearson Ranch Road from Avery Ranch Boulevard to Neenah Avenue, as well as installing a flex post protected intersection at Neenah Avenue and Pearson Ranch Road.

To meet the submittal deadline, this resolution will be effective immediately upon passage.
