CTECC 1.0

- Combined Transportation Emergency and Communications Center (CTECC)

- Partnership for Over 20 Years

- Travis County
- Texas Dept. of Transportation
- City of Austin
- Capital Metro



- Provides Emergency Management, 9-1-1 Call Handling and Dispatch, and Transportation Management (freeways)
- 8 agencies have an operational presence at CTECC



CTECC 2.0

Scope:

- Establish a next generation Transportation Management Center
 - Manage regional transportation as **One System** for travelers
 - Enhance collaboration across agencies and modes
- Establish a 2nd “live” operational facility
 - Improve Austin’s resiliency
 - Address space needs
- Regional Approach – invite other government organizations to join

Drivers:

- Inadequate space for regional collaboration
- Backup center lease expires April 2027



CTECC 2.0

Accomplishments:

- **April 2022** — CTECC Governing Board takes action to move forward with 2nd operational facility
- **January, 2023** — UT Austin selected to develop Concept of Operations
- **Spring 2023** — Governing Board sends letter of interest to governmental agencies in Central Texas

Goals:

- **Summer 2023** — List of interested organizations
- **End of 2023** — Complete Concept of Operations
