

1 **RESOLUTION NO.**

2 **WHEREAS**, on May 6, 2023, special municipal elections were held to
3 present to the voters two citizen-initiated ordinances to amend the City Code by
4 enacting an Austin Police Oversight Act, with one proposed ordinance circulated by
5 Equity Austin (Proposition A) and another proposed ordinance circulated by Voters
6 for Oversight and Police Accountability (Proposition B); voters were given the
7 option of voting “for” or “against” each measure; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the returns of the special elections have been made to the
9 Council and show that the votes for and against the propositions were cast as follows:

16 **WHEREAS**, a majority of all votes cast in the Proposition A special election
17 were cast (for/against) Proposition A, and a majority of all votes cast in the
18 Proposition B special election were cast (for/against) Proposition B; **NOW,**

20 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

21 The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true
22 and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

23 The Council finds that the results of the special elections as tabulated and
24 canvassed reflect the votes cast at the elections; and

25 The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special elections, as
26 tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that Proposition A (is/is not)
27 adopted, and Proposition B (is/is not) adopted.

28 With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received
29 from the counties.
