

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2023, special municipal elections were held to present to the voters two citizen-initiated ordinances to amend the City Code by enacting an Austin Police Oversight Act, with one proposed ordinance circulated by Equity Austin (Proposition A) and another proposed ordinance circulated by Voters for Oversight and Police Accountability (Proposition B); voters were given the option of voting “for” or “against” each measure; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the special elections have been made to the Council and show that the votes for and against the propositions were cast as follows:

Proposition A

For	53,258
Against	13,931

Proposition B

For	12,951
Against	53,415

WHEREAS, a majority of all votes cast in the Proposition A special election were cast for Proposition A, and a majority of all votes cast in the Proposition B special election were cast against Proposition B; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the special elections as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the elections; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special elections, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that Proposition A is adopted, and Proposition B is not adopted.

With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from the counties.
