#### Council Committee, Boards and Commission Action:

May 19, 2022 - The Austin Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) authorized the negotiation and execution of a loan agreement with Foundation Communities, Inc., or an affiliated entity, in an amount not to exceed \$3,300,000 for a rental development to be known as Juniper Creek, located at or near 11630 North Lamar Boulevard, Austin, Texas 78753.

#### Additional Backup Information:

If approved, AHFC is authorized to enter into a new or amended loan agreement and related documents with FC Juniper Creek Housing, LP, or an affiliated entity, to provide \$3,300,000 in additional funds, for a total amount of \$6,600,000, for a rental development to be located in Council District 7.

Funding Request: \$3,300,000 (2022 General Obligation Bonds).

Prior Funding: The development recently approved the negotiation and execution of a loan agreement with Foundation Communities, Inc., or an affiliated entity in an amount not to exceed \$3,300,000. If the current request is approved, total AHFC funding for this project will be \$6,600,000.

Development Information: Development funding is to be utilized for development costs of a 110-unit development, of which 66 units will be affordable to households with incomes at or below 50 percent median family income.
