ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Emergency Reserve Fund shall be used to provide for temporary financing for unanticipated or unforeseen extraordinary needs of an emergency nature. These funds will transfer to the Austin Resource Recovery Fund to support expenditures related to winter storm Mara. As of the City's Five-Year Financial Forecast, total General Fund reserves were projected to end FY 2022-23 at 19.4% of ongoing expenditures. This action would reduce the projection for total year-end General Fund reserve levels to 18.2% of ongoing expenditures. Reimbursement is projected to be 75% of eligible Mara-related expenses, or \$15,363,750. FEMA reimbursements for these expenses will be booked to the General Fund Emergency Reserve when they are ultimately received.
