Additional Backup Information:

This action would set the public hearing on July 20, 2023, for PID 2024 assessment. The proposed 2024 assessment rate of \$0.20 per \$100 valuation is estimated to produce \$265,535 at an 85 percent collection rate. The estimate is the assessment value for the PID as of July 28, 2022, and will be brought back to Council for revision in July should the City receive updated values from the Travis County Appraisal District.

State law requires a public hearing by Council to consider the proposed 2024 assessments. Approval of the proposed assessment rate and roll on June 8, 2023, allows notices to be sent to property owners, giving them an opportunity to review the property valuations prior to the public hearing. Property owners have a right to challenge their assessment at the hearing. At the hearing, Council must hear and pass on any objection, made orally or in writing, to any proposed assessment, prior to approval of the ordinance levying assessments and setting the method of collection and the rate of interest for late payments. Council will hold the public hearing and consider the approval of the PID 2024-2025 Service and Assessment Plan and Budget on July 20, 2023.



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
