ECG Daffan, LP, or an affiliated entity, seeks funding for the development through 4% Low Income Housing Tax Credits (4% LIHTCs) and private activity bonds. The property is located within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

Proposed Development

ECG Daffan, LP, which is an affiliate of Elmington Affordable Housing and the Strategic Housing Finance Corporation, plans to develop a 247-unit multi-family development to be located at 7400 Daffan Lane, Austin, Texas 78724. The community will provide 13 units affordable to households earning at or below 30 percent of the Area Median Family Income (MFI) and 234 units affordable to households earning at or below 60 percent MFI. The intended target population of the development is the general population.

Financing for the development is proposed to come in part from 4% LIHTCs and private activity bonds issued by Strategic Housing Finance Corporation.

The general partner of the development's partnership will be an affiliate of Strategic Housing Finance Corporation. Because of the affiliation with Strategic Housing Finance Corporation the property will be exempt from property tax. No funding from the Austin Housing Finance Corporation is being requested.
