The Austin Design Commission recommends that the 1700 Guadalupe Street project, as presented on December 17, 2018, is in substantial compliance with the Urban Design Guidelines. The Commission further recommends that the project utilize wayfinding solutions for circulation in and around the plaza. Lastly should any substantial design changes happen to the office building or plaza, the Commission would request to review the project for compliance again.
