City Charter Article X. Planning

- Comprehensive planning as a continuous function
- Policies for growth, development, and beautification
- All land development regulations and all public improvement shall be consistent with the comprehensive plan
- Planning Commission powers and duties, in Part:

Prepare periodic evaluation and appraisal reports on the comprehensive plan, which shall be sent to the council at least once every five years after the adoption of the comprehensive plan or element or portion thereof

Creative Economy

Game Changer

The Cultural Trust has been formed as part of the Austin Economic Development Corporation (AEDC) to support acquisition and preservation of arts, cultural, and music spaces.

2018 Proposition B Bond for seven named projects

- AEDC created to accomplish, through purchases and long-term leases, create affordable space supporting artists, arts organizations, and preserves historic and iconic cultural buildings for creative uses
- Bond projects are underway, with the first to be completed in 2025

Sustainable Water

Game Changer

Water Forward Plan, a 100-year integrated water resource plan to plan and implement environmentally conscious water management strategies

- My ATX Water Program, the City's smart meter system, initiated in 2020. My ATX modernizes water metering and monitoring and achieve water conservation goals of the *Water Forward Plan*
 - As of October 2022, ~75,000 meters replaced with My ATX meters
- Aquifer Storage and Recovery Pilot
 Phase 1 Completion anticipated 2024

Healthy Austin

Game Changer

Incorporating health considerations into program and policy decision-making while considering the influence of race, income levels, education, and the built environment on health Activities

- 2017 Mayor's Taskforce on Institutional Racism and Systemic Inequities Report

Game Changer

Project Connect's antidisplacement fund to mitigate the displacement of vulnerable populations impacted by transit development and construction

- \$300M approved for anti-displacement activities. Equitable implementation guided by:
 - Nothing About Us Without Us report
 - Racial Equity Anti-DisplacementTool informed by Racial EquityCatalysts



Workforce, Small Business, & Education

Workforce development initiatives, including the Austin Metro Area Community Workforce Plan City and County coordination with Workforce Solutions Capital Area to provide area training and act as a hub for locals to further their careers

Imagine Austin: 5 Year Action Plan

Goal	Activity
Coordinate Imagine Austin next steps holistically	 Coordinate more regularly with IA Priority Program Champions and partner organizations to ensure alignment of activity and priority setting. Establish and execute an Action Plan for the next five years.
Update & implement Imagine Austin	 Update IA for equity, affordability, resilience and sustainability based on outcomes of earlier steps / findings. Recommend alignment for strategic and long-range planning in the City. Create citywide Future Land Use Map, starting with areas that do not have FLUMs. Develop & coordinate prioritized IA implementation. Simplify reporting for user-ease and transparency.



Imagine Austin: 5 Year Action Plan

Goal	Activity
Establish equitable planning processes and investments	 Establish unified approach to center equity in all new planning. Establish processes that achieve equitable ends for engagement with city activity. Coordinate interdepartmentally to identify capital projects from equitable plans, or through needs identified with an equity lens.
Update key development regulations	 Evaluate key land development regulations pertaining to disparate impacts on disproportionally impacted Austinites. Identify options to modify equitably. Determine a new approach to amend the Land Development Code. Amend the Land Development Code to support the implementation of Equitable Transit Oriented Development.
