
The purpose of Right of Way Management is to provide planning and coordination for all activities in the right of way to protect existing infrastructure, minimize public inconvenience, and ensure public and worker safety during construction and other temporary uses of public right of way.

- Inspection and Enforcement



Permitting and Project Coordination


- Working in the ROW requires a permit. (approximately 30,000 requests/year).
- Coordinate with other work...
 - City work
 - Franchise utilities
 - Private development
 - Special events/filming
 - ... and more (3,500 average active permits at any one time)





Traffic Control Plan Review

- State law and city code requirement
- Ensure that TCPs meet national, state, and local requirements and practices
- Review for safety and mobility
- Approximately 3,000 reviews per year





Utility Coordination

- Process that provides information on utilities for project design to avoid utility conflicts and prevent utility damage
- Both public and private utilities participate
- Approximately 700 cases/year





Inspection and Enforcement

- Ensure City Code is followed by checking that work is permitted and has adhered to approved conditions
- Address safety and mobility issues
- Protect infrastructure.
