Recommendation:

The AAC recommends that the current part-time Public Health Educator position be made a full-time permanent position.

Description of Recommendation to Council:

The AAC passed the following resolution:

The Animal Advisory Commission recommends that the position of Public Health Educator working with the Community Cat program at Austin Animal Center be made a full-time permanent position.

Rationale:

The AAC recognizes the need for the Austin Animal Center to have a public-facing position to help orchestrate and provide services to communities in Austin and Travis County relating to community cats. The position should be a full-time, permanent, cooperative position dedicated to helping communities obtain the services they need to care for and, through free and low-cost spay-neuter services, reduce the number of community cats in Austin and Travis County.
