NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE

The Director of the Watershed Protection Department proposes to adopt the following rule after August 8, 2023.

Comments on the proposed rule are requested from the public. Comments should be submitted to Kelly Strickler, at <u>kelly.strickler@austintexas.gov</u> or (512) 974-1845. To be considered, comments must be submitted before August 7, 2023 the 32nd day after the date this notice is posted. A summary of the written comments received will be included in the notice of rule adoption that must be posted for the rule to become effective.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF PROPOSED RULE

A rule proposed in this notice may not become effective before the effective date established by a separate notice of rule adoption. A notice of rule adoption may not be posted before August 7, 2023 (the 32nd day after the date of this notice) or not after September 14, 2023 (the 70th day after the date of this notice).

If a proposed rule is not adopted on or before September 14, 2023, it is automatically withdrawn and cannot be adopted without first posting a new notice of a proposed rule.

BRIEF EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED RULE

Standards Manual

- SPD 660-3, Rain Garden Typical Inlet Detail 1 Proposed changes to rain garden in the right of way details include removing the rip rap or flagstone splash pad and replacing this requirement with a concrete splash pad.
- <u>SPD 660-4, Rain Garden Typical Inlet Detail 2</u> The width of the rain garden inlet was expanded from two feet to four feet.
- These modifications were necessary to ensure that stormwater is conveyed into the rain garden for treatment. The rock rip rap and flagstone splashpads were causing sediment to build up at the two-foot-wide inlet, blocking flows from entering the rain garden for treatment.

AUTHORITY FOR ADOPTION OF PROPOSED RULE


