2	WHEREAS, on August 26, 2010, the City of Austin, Texas (City) passed
3	Resolution No. 20100826-026 authorizing the creation of the Whisper Valley
4	Public Improvement District (District) pursuant to Texas Local Government Code
5	Chapter 372 (Act); and
6	WHEREAS, the City authorized the creation of the District to finance
7	certain public improvements authorized by the Act for the benefit of the property
8	within the District (Authorized Improvements); and
9	WHEREAS, the development of the District is occurring in multiple phases
10	as described in the Preliminary Service and Assessment Plan (Preliminary SAP),
11	the first phase being approximately 80.0 acres located within the District
12	(Improvement Area #1), the second phase being approximately 54.5 acres located
13	within the District (Improvement Area #2), the third phase being approximately
14	112.3 acres located within the District (Improvement Area #3), and the remaining
15	property to be developed as future improvement areas, being approximately
16	1,819.2 acres located within the District; and
17	WHEREAS, the Whisper Valley Public Improvement District 2023
18	Amended and Restated Service and Assessment Plan (2023 SAP), including the

proposed assessment roll for Improvement Area #3 (Proposed Assessment Roll

- and, together with the 2023 SAP, the Preliminary SAP), is attached as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS, the Preliminary SAP sets forth the estimated total costs of
 certain Authorized Improvements benefitting the property within Improvement
 Area #3 to be financed by the District, and the Proposed Assessment Roll states the
 assessments proposed to be levied against each parcel of land in Improvement
 Area #3, as determined by the method of assessment chosen by the City; and
 WHEREAS, the Act requires that the Proposed Assessment Roll be filed
 with the City Clerk and be subject to public inspection; and
 - WHEREAS, the Act requires that a public hearing (Assessment Hearing) be called to consider proposed assessments and requires the Council to hear and pass on any objections to the proposed assessments at, or on the adjournment of, the Assessment Hearing; and

- WHEREAS, the Act requires that notice of the Assessment Hearing be mailed to property owners liable for assessment and published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City and the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction before the 10th day before the date of the Assessment Hearing;
- WHEREAS, the Council's final determination and approval of the costs of the Authorized Improvements benefitting property located in Improvement Area #3 shall be subject to and contingent upon the Council's approval, after the

40	Assessment Hearing, of a final Service and Assessment Plan, including the final

42	WHEREAS, the City and Club Deal 120 Whisper Valley, Limited				
43	Partnership, the developer of the District (Developer) responsible for the				
44	construction of public improvements to serve Improvement Area #3 of the District,				
45	will enter into a Whisper Valley Public Improvement District Acquisition and				
46	Reimbursement Agreement Improvement Area #3 (Acquisition and				
47	Reimbursement Agreement) in substantially the form attached as Exhibit B; NOW,				
48	THEREFORE,				
49	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:				
50 51	The Council approves the Preliminary SAP for the District, including the				
52	Proposed Assessment Roll. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this				
53	Resolution shall have the meanings given them in the Preliminary SAP.				
54	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:				
55	The Council determines that the total costs of the Authorized Improvements				
56	benefitting property located in Improvement Area #3 to be financed by the District				
57	are as set forth in Section V.C(4) of the Preliminary SAP, which costs do not				
58	include the payment of expenses incurred in the administration of the District.				
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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

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The Council directs that the Proposed Assessment Roll be filed with the City
Clerk and be available for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Council directs the City Clerk to publish notice of the Assessment

Hearing to be held on August 31, 2023, in substantially the form attached as

Exhibit C, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City and the City's

extraterritorial jurisdiction, on or before August 15, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

When the Proposed Assessment Roll is filed with the City Clerk, the
Council directs the City Clerk to mail to owners of property liable for assessment
notice of the Assessment Hearing to be held on August 31, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Council approves the Acquisition and Reimbursement Agreement in substantially the form attached as Exhibit B. The City Manager, Mayor, and Mayor Pro Tem of the City are each authorized and directed to execute and deliver such Acquisition and Reimbursement Agreement with such changes as may be required to carry out the purpose of this Resolution and as approved by the City Manager, Mayor, or Mayor Pro Tem, such approval to be evidenced by the execution thereof.
