Posting Language

Authorize execution of a contract for 145kv metering current transformers with KBS Electrical Distributors Inc., for a term of five years in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.

For the goods required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established.

June 12, 2023 - Recommended by the Electric Utility Commission on a 8-0 vote with Commissioners Bowen and Hopkins absent and one vacancy.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract is to provide 145kv metering current transformers for Austin Energy. Metering current transformers are used for the protection from, measurement, and control of electrical currents in high-voltage electrical substations. These transformers are a crucial safety component for protecting Austin Energy personnel and substation equipment. Metering current transformers step down high primary currents to low secondary currents, limiting and minimizing the current for metering which protects against power surges that

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could result in failures of critical substation equipment.
