# Additional Backup Information:

On April 24, 2023, Presiding Judge, Sherry Statman, briefed the Public Safety Committee requesting an increase of substitute judicial salaries to be equivalent to those of full-time associate judges. The substitute judges perform the same duties as associate judges and, historically, they have been compensated at the same rate. Judge Statman also requested a stipend for each hour worked as a magistrate at the Travis County Central Booking Facility due to the complexity of the work, location, and 24/7 staffing requirement. This item was sponsored by Mayor Kirk Watson and Council Member José "Chito" Vela.

The Municipal Court worked with the Law Department to amend the existing judicial appointment ordinance to include the new salary provisions.
