Additional Backup Information:

The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) program is a preventative program that serves women and children below 185% of the federal poverty level. The WIC Program provides nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and nutritious foods to pregnant women, infants, and children up to age five.

The WIC grant provides funding to the City for the WIC Program and requires Austin Public Health (APH) to serve Bastrop County. Bastrop Independent School District is requesting WIC services at their locations using the WIC Mobile Unit to facilitate access to benefits for families in their schools. Approval of this item will enable APH to comply with the WIC grant requirements and increase Bastrop County resident participation in the WIC Program, which will result in increased revenue for the WIC Program and benefit Travis County residents receiving WIC services.
