ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 12-4-64 (*TABLE OF* SPEED LIMITS) TO ESTABLISH A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 15 MILES PER HOUR ON SEGMENTS OF ESCARPMENT BOULEVARD, TRISSINO DRIVE, AND BERNIA DRIVE FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING BEAR CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AND PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Subsection (D) of City Code Section 12-4-64 (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add:

Escarpment Boulevard from 160 feet north of Trissino Drive to 600 feet south of Trissino Drive. (15 MPH) (SZ)

Escarpment Boulevard from 160 feet north of Bernia Drive to 60 feet south of Bernia Drive. (15 MPH) (SZ)

Trissino Drive from 120 feet west of Escarpment Boulevard to 120 feet east of Escarpment Boulevard. (15 MPH) (SZ)

Bernia Drive from 120 feet west of Escarpment Boulevard to 80 feet east of Escarpment Boulevard. (15 MPH) (SZ)

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance are based on the results of a traffic engineering investigation, or "speed study," referenced in the Memorandum attached as Exhibit "A".

PART 3. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing entries reordered accordingly.

PART 4. Council finds that school will soon be in session and the need for a school zone at this site constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
