APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approve the minutes from the Firefighters', Police Officers', and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission Regular Meeting of May 1, 2023.

- 4. Discussion and possible action regarding the request of an Austin Police Department candidate to the Commission to appoint three-member boards per Chapter 143.022(c) TLGC for another mental or physical examination. (Dylan Martin).
 - The motion to approve the appointment of a three-member board per Chapter 143.022(c) LGC for another mental or physical examination was approved on Vice Chair Ahmed's motion, Chair Thomas' second, on a 2-0 vote.
