- 3) Install a new pocket park with steel guard rail, granite table, step light, and ramps.
- 4) Install new metal bike racks.
- 5) Install new granite bench.
- 6) Install new irrigation system.

DESIGN STANDARDS

The City of Austin's <u>Historic Design Standards</u> (March 2021) are based on the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and are used to evaluate projects in National Register districts. The following standards apply to the proposed project:

Sites and streetscapes

5. Sidewalks, driveways, and parking

The proposed project replaces the existing non-historic pavers in-kind. They do not impact the historic fabric in the district.
