Grant Overview

The Heritage Preservation Grant promotes tourism by restoring historic sites, and through planning, educational, or marketing projects. Projects should tell inclusive stories on historic places rooted in Austin's history and heritage.

Based on State Statute Ch. 351, the project must:

- Be used for historical restoration and preservation projects or activities to encourage tourism to visit preserved historic sites.
- At, or in the immediate vicinity of, Convention Center facilities or visitor information centers;
- Located in the areas that would be frequented by tourists and convention delegates; and



Eligibility Requirements

- Non-profit and for-profit entities eligible;
- Historic-designated sites that promote heritage tourism;
- Historic preservation projects and history-informing activities;
- Accessible Grounds and Non-Residential Zoning
- Marketed to Increase/Benefit Tourism and Expand Audiences
- Occur within an Austin City Council District



Priorities

- Outreach to First-time Applicants;
- Tourism-serving properties listed in the East Austin Historic
 Survey;
- Inclusive Interpretive Plans & Story-Telling: Projects that share Austin's history in a fresh and compelling way;
- Creative Collaborations Encouraged: Partnerships between historic properties and community organizations;
- **Tourism:** Use of innovative and inclusive methods to attract new and diverse audiences and tourists.


