This memo provides the final staff response to <u>Resolution No. 20211104-039</u>, relating to Fence Designs, which directed staff to initiate code amendments to City Code Chapter 25-12 (Technical Codes) to address dangerous fence design including spiked pickets, spiked bars and other spiked decorative elements that protrude above the top horizontal bar of a fence. The following changes were directed by council:

- Requiring flat top styles on new fences of all lengths.
- Applying flat top fence requirements to all new fences of six feet tall or lower.
- Applying flat top fence requirements to substantial fence repairs or remodeling of 50% or more of an existing fence

Staff presented these changes to the Planning Commission on May 23, 2023, where they were approved on a vote of 8-0. These changes were also brought forward for council consideration as agenda <u>ltem 156</u> on the July 20, 2023, Council Meeting agenda where they were approved and the ordinance adopted.
