Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract for Medicare Advantage with Health Care Service Corporation d/b/a Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas, for one year in an amount not to exceed \$9,000,000.

(Note: This solicitation was reviewed for subcontracting opportunities in accordance with City Code Chapter 2-9C (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). For the services required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established).

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide an alternative medical and pharmacy benefit plan to our post 65 retiree population. The City has sole responsibility for the plan design. The plan year for all services will be January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The City is anticipating an expense reduction to the health plan expenditures upon implementation of this contract. This type of plan offering is not only cost-beneficial to retirees and the City, but also aligns with market benchmarks. Most municipalities and other entities that offer retiree medical benefits, do so through a Medicare Advantage plan.

A new contract must be finalized before September 1, 2023 to allow adequate time for implementation of the services for coverage to begin January 1, 2024 and for the Human Resources Department to develop

materials for Open Enrollment scheduled to begin October 9, 2023.

An evaluation team with expertise in this area evaluated the offers and scored Health Care Service Corporation d/b/a Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas, as the best to provide these services based on proposed plan design, medical coverage and network, plan administration and implementation, price, local preference, and service-disabled veteran business enterprise.
