This action requests City Council to conduct a public hearing to hear public comments on the water, wastewater, and reclaimed rate changed proposed in the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Operating Budget City Council is scheduled to adopt the budget on August 16, 17, and 18, 2023. The City Code in Section 2-5-45 specifically requires a public hearing prior to the City Council approving any changes in electric, water, wastewater, and garbage collection rates.
