ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The current FY 2022-2023 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund includes \$370,000 in grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance. APD received a grant award in the amount of \$388,889, which is \$18,889 more than anticipated. No match is required.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Austin Police Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
