



# Pilot Program Nexus Overview

<b>Selection Process</b>	3 COA Staff + Rubric
<b>Total Available Funds</b>	~\$500,000
<b>Award Amounts</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>
<b>Number of Awardees</b>	<b>100</b> <i>(50 per cycle; 2 cycles/year)</i>



# Nexus Timeline (*first cycle!*)



- **Cycle 2:** Application Opens **January 2024** (events April '24 – September '24); 50 awards
- **Cycle 3:** Application Opens **July 2024** (events October '24 – March '25); 50 awards


- 103 total (42% of the applications in Nexus)

- Funds come from National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) – American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grants to Local Arts Agencies for Subgranting
- **19** Awards to Arts Education Non-Profits
- **\$25,000** flat grant
- Application Opened: Tuesday, **August 8** at 10am
- Application Deadline: Tuesday, **September 12** at 5pm
- Panel review: **September 27th**
- Award announcements: **September 29th**
- Community Partner: **MINDPOP**

## KEY ELEMENTS

- This program funds **arts education non-profits**
- Arts Education activities **primarily serve** participants **from early childhood through 18 years**
- **At least 50% of the award must be paid to teaching artists** providing direct services to students
