Why we're here — Changes to the City's MBE/WBE Program



- Upcoming changes to MBE/WBE Program
 - Completed newest Disparity Study in 2022
 - Study outcomes driving changes to City's MBE/WBE Program
 - o Council adopted Disparity Study in Nov. 2022, including further direction
- Direction from Council with their adoption of the Disparity Study
 - Explore new race/gender neutral program(s) that would also benefit MBE/WBE firms
 - o Include local preference and small businesses in this review
 - Align implementation of any new program or revisions, with changes to the City's MBE/WBE Program

Stakeholder Engagement and Feedback



Engagement

- Met with several local Chambers and stakeholders (list available)
- Conducted online survey
- Review of similar programs of other governments

Feedback

- Continue supporting existing MBE/WBE Program (strong emphasis)
- Maintain Local and Small programs separately
- Equal priority for Local and Small (percents / points)
- o Include Local and Small subcontractors, if possible
- Small status based on federal Small Size Standard
- Local status based on Greater Austin
- Local status based on Headquarters
- o Concern that enhancements may not positively impact all groups equally

Program Enhancements – (New)



- Begin 2-Year Demo Period (10/01/2023 09/30/2025)
 - Cap both programs to \$50M (single solicitation / contract limit)
 - Monitor and Report on program(s) performance
 - Control against negative impacts to other programs
 - Determine program elements that may be revised further

Local Preference

- Revise & streamline program criteria
- Optimize preferences where necessary

Small Business

- Implement Small Business elements above \$50,000
- Mirror Small Business preferences consistent with Local Preference

Local Preference – City's Program (Current/New)



- What is Local?
 - Companies with Headquarters or Branch Office in the Local Area
 - Limit to Companies with Headquarters in the Local Area only
- Where is Local Area?
 - Austin, Full Purpose Jurisdiction
 - Expand to Greater Austin (5-County, "Austin-Round Rock, MSA")
- Preference Conditions and Amounts
 - Goods & Services (Above \$50K: 3% Invitation for Bids (IFB), 10 pts Request for Proposals (RFP))
 - Construction (Below \$100K: 5% IFB, 5 pts RFP)
 - Goods, Services & Construction (Below \$100K: 5% IFB, 10 pts RFP)
 - Goods & Services (\$100K \$500K: 5% IFB, 10 pts RFP)
 - Goods & Services (\$500K \$50M: 3% IFB, 6 pts RFP)
- Subcontractors
 - Goods and Services only
 - Limit to Prime Contractors only during demo period



Small Businesses

Small Businesses – City's Program (Current/Proposed)



- What is Small?
 - Federal Small Business Size Standard / Continue same
- Who is Small?
 - City of Austin (MBE, WBE, Small Business Enterprise (SBE) / Continue same)
 - State of Texas (Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) / HUB & SBE)
 - o Federal (Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) / DBE & Small Business Admin. (SBA))
- Preference Conditions and Amounts
 - o Goods & Services (\$5K-50K): Solicitations may be limited to Small Businesses only / Continue same
 - Goods, Services & Construction (Below \$100K: 5% IFB, 10 pts RFP)
 - Goods & Services (\$100K \$500K: 5% IFB, 10 pts RFP)
 - Goods & Services (\$500K \$50M: 3% IFB, 6 pts RFP)
- Subcontractors
 - Limit to Prime Contractors only / Continue same
