NOTICE OF RULE ADOPTION

The Director of the Watershed Protection Department has adopted the following rule. Notice of the proposed rule was posted on July 6, 2023. Public comment on the proposed rule was solicited in the July 6, 2023 notice. This notice is issued under Chapter 1-2 of the City Code. The adoption of a rule may be appealed to the City Manager in accordance with Section 1-2-10 of the City Code as explained below.

A copy of the complete text of the adopted rule is attached to this notice.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF ADOPTED RULE

A rule adopted by this notice is effective on August 29, 2023.

TEXT OF ADOPTED RULE

R161-23.18: Modifies the Standards Manual as follows:

Standards Manual

- SPD 660-3, Rain Garden Typical Inlet Detail 1 Proposed changes to rain garden in the right of way details include removing the rip rap or flagstone splash pad and replacing this requirement with a concrete splash pad.
- SPD 660-4, Rain Garden Typical Inlet Detail 2 The width of the rain garden inlet was expanded from two feet to four feet.
- These modifications were necessary to ensure that stormwater is conveyed into the rain garden for treatment. The rock rip rap and flagstone splashpads were causing sediment to build up, blocking flows from entering the rain garden for treatment.

COMMENTS AND CHANGES FROM PROPOSED RULE

No comments were received, and no changes were made.

AUTHORITY FOR ADOPTION OF RULE

The authority and procedure for the adoption of a rule to assist in the implementation, administration, or enforcement of a provision of the City Code is established in Chapter 1-2 of the

City Code. The authority to regulate design and construction of drainage facilities and improvements is established in Section 25-7-64 of the City Code.

APPEAL OF ADOPTED RULE TO CITY MANAGER

A person may appeal the adoption of a rule to the City Manager. **AN APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK NOT LATER THAN THE 30TH DAY AFTER THE DATE THIS NOTICE OF RULE ADOPTION IS POSTED. THE POSTING DATE IS NOTED ON THE FIRST PAGE OF THIS NOTICE.** If the 30th day is a Saturday, Sunday, or official city holiday, an appeal may be filed on the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday, or official city holiday.

An adopted rule may be appealed by filing a written statement with the City Clerk. A person who appeals a rule must (1) provide the person's name, mailing address, and telephone number; (2) identify the rule being appealed; and (3) include a statement of specific reasons why the rule should be modified or withdrawn.


Notice that an appeal was filed and will be posted by the city clerk. A copy of the appeal will be provided to the City Council. An adopted rule will not be enforced pending the City Manager's decision. The City Manager may affirm, modify, or withdraw an adopted rule. If the City Manager does not act on an appeal on or before the 60th day after the date the notice of rule adoption is posted, the rule is withdrawn. Notice of the City Manager's decision on an appeal will be posted by the city clerk and provided to the City Council.

On or before the 16th day after the city clerk posts notice of the City Manager's decision, the City Manager may reconsider the decision on an appeal. Not later than the 31st day after giving written notice of an intent to reconsider, the City manager shall make a decision.

TYPICAL INLET DETAIL 1

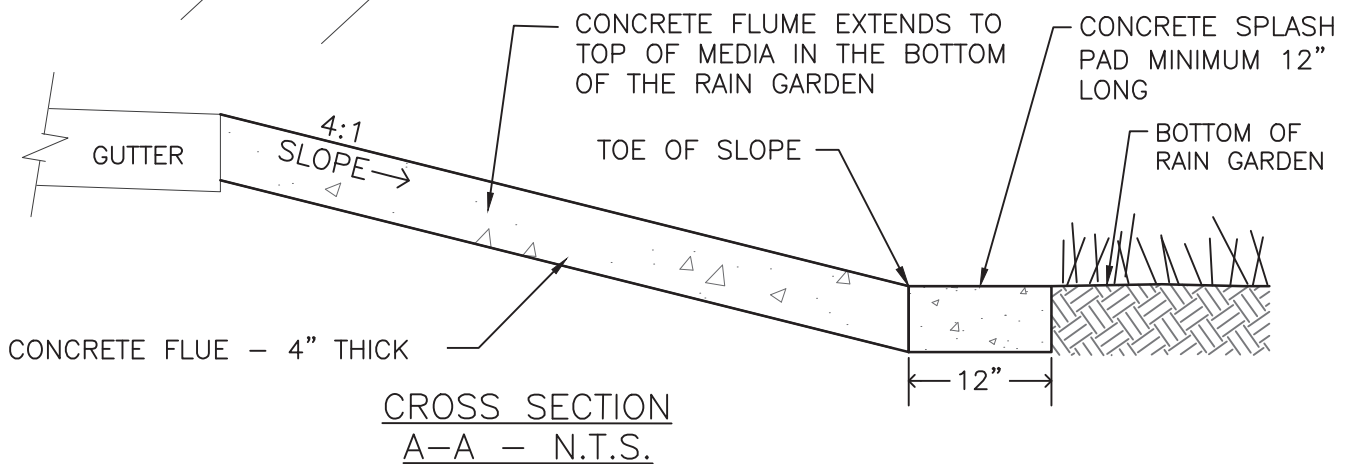
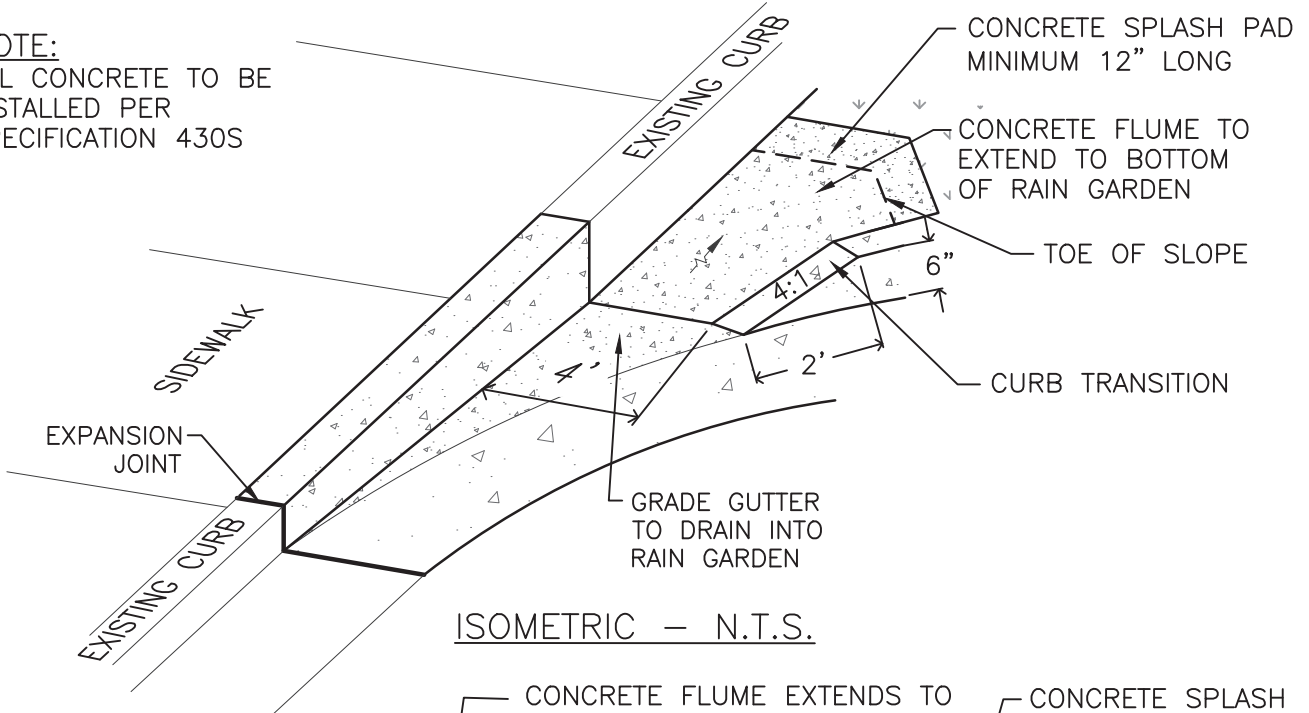

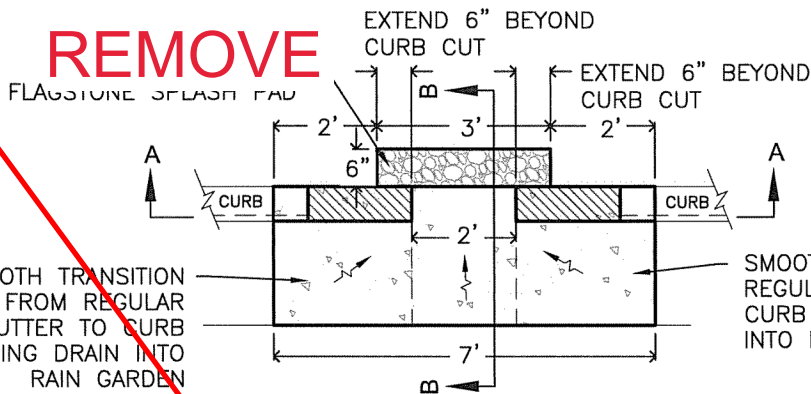

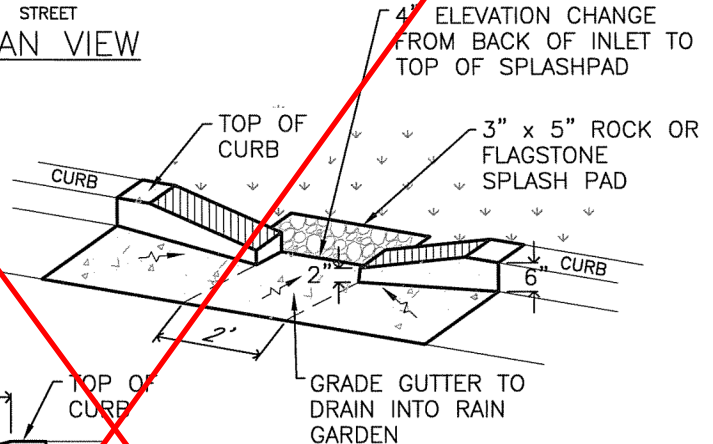

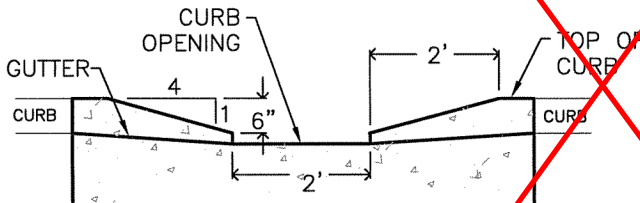

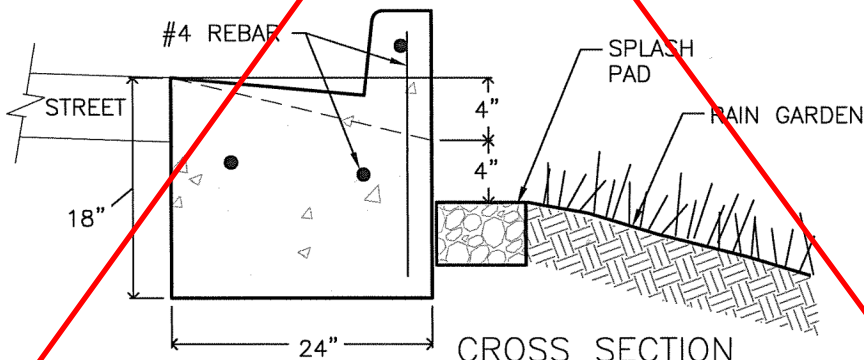
STREET

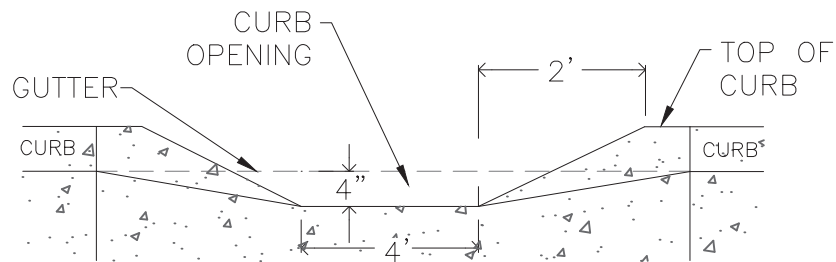
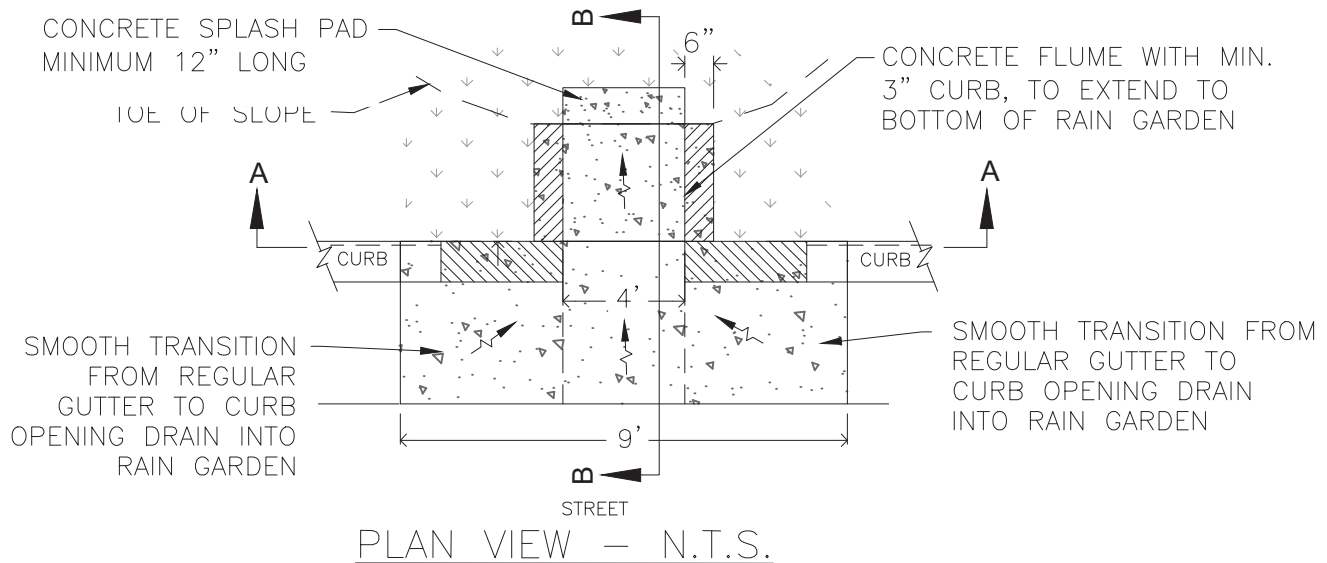

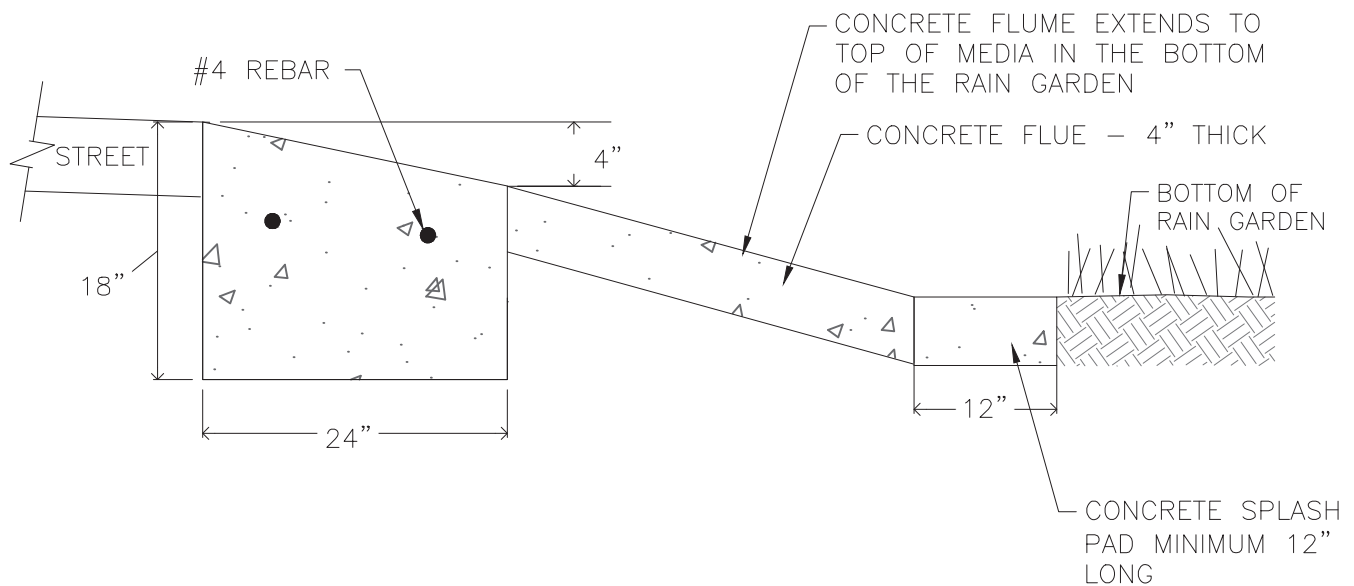
