Fiscal Note

Each entity listed below would reimburse the City of Austin for services provided and for parts used for communication equipment installations, repairs, and maintenance. Revenue to the City of Austin is projected to be an estimated \$5,000 annually per entity.

Prior Council Action:

The City of Austin has executed numerous interlocal agreements of this type over the past 27 years with other government entities in Austin and elsewhere in Texas for communication equipment services and parts.
