

Comprehensive Coverage Saves Austin Millions

HAAM's Premium Assistance Programs provide over **\$14 million of healthcare coverage every year** to musicians who would otherwise be unfunded.

Increasing all around access to care




Partnerships, philanthropy, &local and federal dollars save our healthcare system


Annual musician premiums cost \$2,000/yr, leveraged into \$8,700/yr of coverage

At least 1000 musicians are eligible but not covered


