ERCOT's Pre-Emergency Notices

What you may see before things get serious

ERCOT Weather Watch

Normal Grid Conditions

Keep an eye on the weather.

Advance notice of weather that could mean tight grid conditions.

Voluntary Conservation Notice

Save energy.

Because of higher electric use and possible lower energy reserves, ERCOT asks Texans to conserve, if safe to do so.

Conservation Appeal

No, really. Save energy.

Higher electric use and possible lower energy reserves look more like conditions could lead into Energy Emergency Alerts.



ERCOT's Energy Emergency Alert Levels

ENERGY
EMERGENCY ALERT
EEA 1

**It's not a joke.
Save energy.**

- Reserves are low.
- Conservation needed.
- ERCOT can use all available power supplies.

ENERGY
EMERGENCY ALERT
EEA 2

**Save energy...
or else.**

- Reserves are lower than EEA 1.
- Conservation is critical.
- ERCOT may interrupt power to large industrial customers.

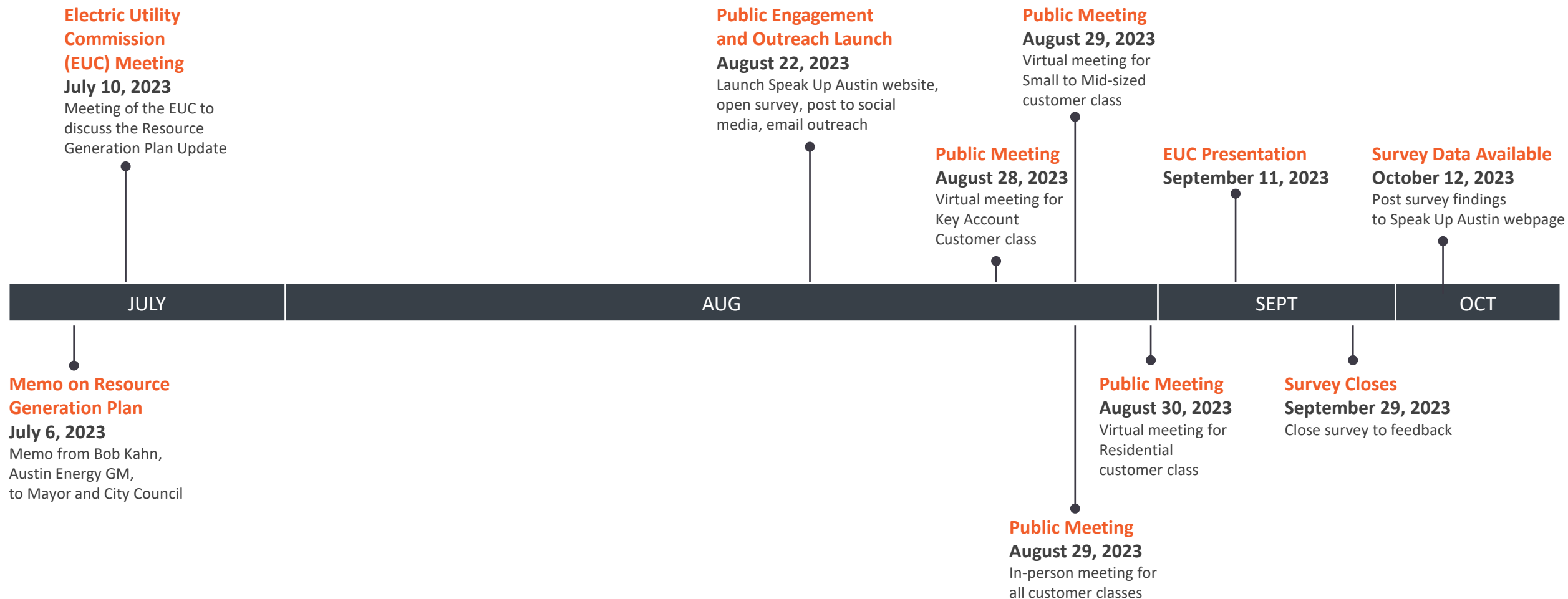
ENERGY

- Reserves are dangerously low.
- Expect controlled outages to protect the statewide grid.

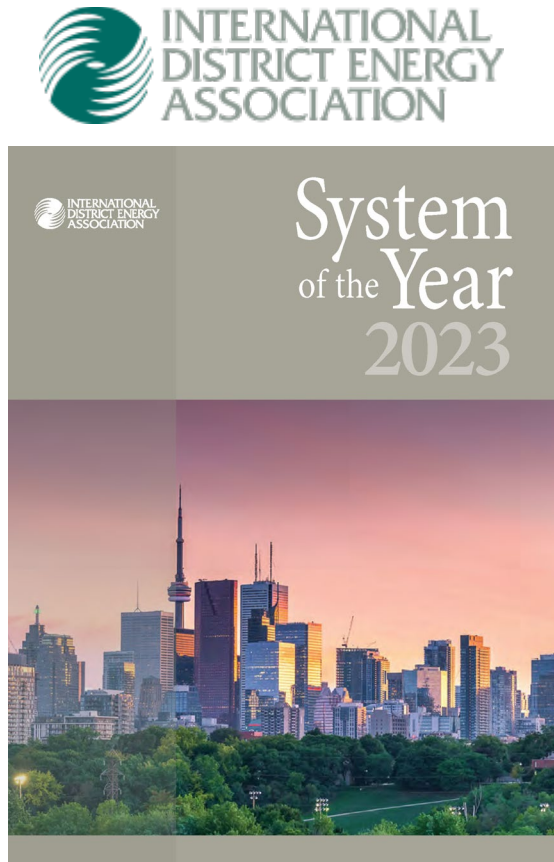
