9/11/2023	My objection to the increase of semi-conductor facilities in the Austin area is based on the enormous amount of energy and water that they use, both of which are becoming more unpredictable as human-induced climate change progresses. We need to think about the future and that of the people already living in the area, not just about jobs. If we don't have water and power, the promise of jobs is moot. The Austin-Travis Lakes watershed, which contains Austin, TX, has experienced 717 weeks (63% of weeks) since 2000 with some of its area in drought of any level, and 212 weeks (19% of weeks) since 2000 with some of its area in Extreme or Exceptional drought. Source: National Drought Monitor. Also, this facilities increasing use of fossil fuels is concerning, given that they are driving the climate crisis. I object to giving this project the agreement and/or any incentives to contribute to water and energy stresses, and increased pollution in the Austin area.

The Chips Act has issued guidance DISCOURAGING the use of firm specific tax abatement. Broader worker development or infrastructure support is preferred to traditional tax abatements or grants to a single company.
