Item 2 - FOLLOW UP QUESTIONS

Response to resistance reports status - April Follow Up
 Assistant Chief Mason will respond at October 2, 2023 meeting.

2. OT hours spent in 911 call center by sworn officers - July Follow Up

At present, there are 29 APD Sergeants who possess the necessary training and authorization to work overtime at the 911 call center. However, only a subset of 4-5 sergeants actively take on shifts. Collective, these sergeants cover approximately 15 shifts each month. The pay scale, which is contingent on their years of service, is provided in the attached document.

Throughout the entire Emergency Communications Center, we pay civilians approximately \$121,000 in overtime.

Item 3 - EMS QUARTERLY

1. Is there a "Don't Use Alone" Hotline in Travis County?

ATCEMS, in conjunction with Austin Public Health, have recently changed the literature in the Narcan Rescue kits we are distributing. The kits now include the "Never Use Alone" Helpline number (1-800-484-3731). This resource combined with a mental health crisis help line, and a number for treatment options from BeWell, give people several options for seeking help with addiction.

2. EMS for next quarterly- how do the OD stats compare to national average?

ATCEMS tracks all overdoses identified in the 911 system. Most state and national opioid tracking is focused on overdose deaths. The State of Texas uses reporting data to establish an opioid (Fentanyl) overdose fatality per 100,000 people. In 2023, Travis County has a fatality overdose rate of 6.29 per 100,000. This is roughly twice that of any other county in Texas. Harris County (Houston) is 3.18 per 100,000. Bexar County (San Antonio) is 3.02 per 100,000.

This statistic is an example of the severity of the Opioid Crisis here in our community, and

why programs like the ATCEMS Buprenorphine Bridge Program are so important
